For anyone struggling with fear, worry, or anxiety, or who wonders how families and communities can live as peacemakers in troubled times, Unafraid offers an informed and inspiring message full of practical solutions. In this 5-session study, we will explore the worries and fears that all of us experience. We can learn to identify fears and discover practical steps for overcoming them, all in the light of scripture. Format includes a short DVD each week with discussion questions following:
